

# What is an IEP Goal?

IEP goals or objectives represent a part of a required fluency or list of skills that describe what a student should accomplish during the school year (IEP cycle). Each objective in the IEP goal progression moves the learner through previously unmastered skills and skill gaps that may span multiple grade levels or be more condensed to a specific grade or developmental range.

Teach Tastic IEP goals written to be SMART: Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Results-oriented and Time-bound.

# **Learning Standard**

L.K.1.C Form regular plural nouns orally by adding /s/ or /es/ (e.g., dog, dogs; wish, wishes).

## **Target Goal**

By (date), when given exercises with language conventions, the student will form regular plural nouns orally by adding /s/ or /es/ when writing and speaking (e.g., dog, dogs; wish, wishes), improving language skills from 0/10 work samples out of ten consecutive trials to 8/10 work samples in ten consecutive trials.

# **Objectives**

### Choose the singular or plural noun that matches the picture

By (date), when given word list and matching picture, the student will choose the singular or plural noun that matches the picture, improving grammar and mechanics skills from 0/10 work samples out of ten consecutive trials to 8/10 work samples in ten consecutive trials.

### Find a word in a sentence

By (date), when given sentences with pictures in them and word selection list, the student will find a word in a sentence, improving reading foundations skills from 0/10 work samples out of ten consecutive trials to 8/10 work samples in ten consecutive trials.

## Word recognition: Choose the sentence that is spaced correctly

By (date), when given sentences given orally or in writing, the student will choose the sentence that is spaced correctly, improving reading foundations skills from 0/10 work samples out of ten consecutive trials to 8/10 work samples in ten consecutive trials.

### Word recognition: Choose the two words that are the same

By (date), when given 3-5 word choices, the student will choose the two words that are the same, improving reading foundations skills from 0/10 work samples out of ten consecutive trials to 8/10 work samples in ten consecutive trials.
